Notes to financial statements:

In the period 1 September 2022 to 25 April 2023, the income exceeds the expenditure by £1,700.

The bank balance (including petty cash) is £3,377; just £39 of this is for use by the gardening club. (Current bank balance includes current year surplus as well as accumulated surpluses from previous years).

Tortoise tote bags:

Total sales of tote bags so far is £1,044. This money has been transferred to the school; they have incurred the expenses of making these bags (PTA contribution was £250). Bag sales income will be transferred to the school until the point that the costs have been covered; any further bag sales will be recognised as income for the PTA.

The fundraising and contributions from parents for the Christmas celebrations exceeded the expenses by £778. This was helped greatly by the wreath making evening and the raffle ticket sales.
