St John's School is registered as a 'controller' under the Data Protection Law (Jersey) 2018. The Data Protection Law is a privacy law which means that St John's School will not release your child's or your data to a third party unless a provision of the Law is met. <b>Website/Marketing.</b> I give permission for my child and his/her image to be used in displays and in brochures published by St John's School and CYPES (Department of Children, Young People, Education Services and to appear on the school website.		
<b>Offsite visit/trip.</b> I give permission for my child to take part in any planned educational visits and understand that St John's School will notify me before events take place, these trips will be offsite, but on island.		
<b>Photography.</b> I give permission for my child's information (name, class, year and school ID number) to be passed to Peter Trenchard Photography so that my child's image can be used on the school's management information system, SIMS and that I may also have the opportunity to purchase his/her photograph each year.		
<b>Competition Entry.</b> I agree for my child & his/her work and full name to be entered in competitions e.g. eisteddfod.

<b>Social Media.</b> I give permission for my child to appear on the St John's School & PTA Facebook & Twitter accounts when the school wishes to celebrate class or whole school activities.		
<b>School Communication.</b> I understand that St John's school use Sims Intouch as the way to communicate to parents and that all parents with Parental Responsibility (PR) will have access to this.		
<b>PG Film.</b> On occasions during school we may show films or parts of films with PG rating, these will have been previously examined by staff for suitability prior to viewing.		
<b>PTA.</b> (St John's School Parent Teacher Association) is a charitable body affiliated to St John's School. From time to time the PTA may contact parents through email/letter to inform them of events etc. I agree for the PTA to have access to my contact details for this purpose. The PTA does not have access to any other personal information that school holds and will not use your contact details for any other purpose.		
<b>Starting School.</b> I agree to the JEP publishing my child's Starting School class photo with their first name only being given to the JEP.		
<b>Opportunities.</b> This covers opportunities for your child to engage in which will be helpful for your child in and out of school e.g. Jersey Music Service, Jersey Sport, extra-curricular clubs etc.
